SPD Detectives had two crime scene callouts and 13 cases assigned for investigation. CID obtained two arrest warrants in ongoing case investigations. The Unit cleared four cases.															
Two officers participated in a multi-agency traffic checkpoint hosted by Mint Hill PD.															
The SPD unwanted medication disposal unit was launched in September 2020. This month the department collected 30 pounds of unwanted medication. Officers assisted EMS to the Gate Gas Station on Lawyers Road in reference to an unconscious person slumped over in a vehicle. SPD officers arrived and began an investigation after EMS determined that there was no medical emergency. Officers suspected the driver of the vehicle was impaired and conducted a DWI investigation and determined that the driver was impaired on alcohol. The driver was arrested for DWI. Traffic stop leads to seizure of two firearms, drugs, and drug paraphernalia. Officers stopped a vehicle for an expired tag. During the stop, the officer noticed the odor of marijuana and began investigating the possibility of illegal drugs in the vehicle. During this investigation the officer discovered two illegally concealed and loaded firearms, several grams of marijuana, and various drug paraphernalia. The driver was arrested for carrying a concealed weapon, possession of marijuana, and no driver's license. Officers assigned to D squad responded to a fatal wreck at the intersection of Stallings Rd and Guion Ln. Officers observed a motorcyclist underneath a pickup truck with noticeable injuries. While on scene, officers and concerned citizens attempted life saving measures; however, the motorcyclist succumbed to his injuries shortly after the collision. Officers assigned to D-shift conducted a thorough investigation and obtained warrants for misdemeanor death by motor vehicle for the suspect who struck the motorcyclist.
