<p>SPD Detectives had two crime scene callouts and had 16 cases assigned for investigation. CID obtained five search warrants and two arrest warrants in ongoing case investigations. The Unit cleared one case with an arrest.</p>												
<p>Proactive traffic stop leads to felony seizure of drugs. On March 19th an officer stopped a vehicle on Old Monroe Road for a traffic violation. The officers's investigation led him to believe that there was a significant amount of illegal drugs in the vehicle. A K9 was deployed to conduct an open-air sniff of the vehicle, and the K9 alerted to the presence of drugs inside the vehicle. A probable cause search of the vehicle yielded a case full of 52 illegal THC vapes along with an additional 30 grams of loose marijuana located inside vehicle. The driver charged with felony possession with intent to sell/ deliver marijuana, and felony maintaining a dwelling/vehicle for the sell/ delivery of drugs.</p>												
<p>Shoplifting call leads to arrest for felony possession of methamphetamine. On March 28th SPD officers responded to a shoplifting call at Walgreens Pharmacy on Potter Road. Upon arrival, officers contacted the suspect who was in the parking lot standing outside his white van. During the initial investigation officers noticed that the suspect was being deceptive and trying to hide the contents of a bag he was in possession of. Our officers decided to be proactive and widen the scope of the lawful investigation by deploying our SPD K9 Kane to check the suspect's vehicle. K9 Kane alerted to the presence of illegal drugs inside the suspect's vehicle. Officers then conducted a probable cause search of the vehicle and located 4 grams of methamphetamine inside the vehicle. The suspect was arrested and charged with felony possession of methamphetamine.</p>
