OCCUPANCY TAX REFERENDUM

WHAT IS AN OCCUPANCY TAX?

An Occupancy Tax, or "hotel tax," is a tax charged to guests staying at hotels, motels, and other lodging establishments within our town.

WHO PAYS AN OCCUPANCY TAX?

An Occupancy Tax is paid by visitors, not residents or property owners, in short-term rentals like hotels or bed and breakfasts establishments.

HOW ARE OCCUPANCY TAX FUNDS USED?

Funds collected through an Occupancy Tax can only be used for travel and tourism promotion and expenditures which can include park facilities.

WHAT IS A REFERENDUM?

A referendum is a direct vote by the people on the ballot.
